Parade of Lights Line-up and Participation Rules & Regulations

In order to provide the best possible experience for all participants and attendees, please help Crete Country Christmas and our Public Safety Agencies ensure that the Parade of Lights is safe, respectful, and memorable for everyone involved.

⊘ REMINDER: NO OPEN ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED on the parade route, in the line-up area, or in any vehicles!

Below are the guidelines that all drivers and participants are required to follow:

1. While the goal is to celebrate, drivers must remain focused on operating their vehicle or float safely and should maintain the same level of awareness as if driving in regular traffic or on the highway.
2. Dangerous or reckless behavior is strictly prohibited. This includes hanging out of vehicle windows, allowing yourself to become distracted, or performing stunts—burnouts or tire spinning is strictly prohibited, and violators will be ticketed.
3. Maintain proper spacing. Avoid creating large gaps between entries. Do not stop unless directed by Public Safety personnel—no unapproved stops are allowed.
4. Be aware of public safety vehicles that may be moving throughout the parade route, including ATVs, Gators, and golf carts. Always follow instructions given by uniformed police officers and volunteers.
5. Remain alert and vigilant. Ensure that everyone on your vehicle or float is safely managed. Use caution when mounting and dismounting.
6. Please do not throw candy or any items from vehicles or floats. If you wish to distribute items, please have walkers hand them out directly to spectators along the route.
7. If you are unsure of what to do, please ask one of the police officers or volunteers along the parade route. We are happy to assist you!
8. See Something, Say Something. If you see anything suspicious or feel unsafe, please report it to any First Responder/volunteer along the parade route.
9. No Santa Claus costumes allowed - the ONLY Santa will be at the end of the parade and will be hosted by Crete Country Christmas
